- 🛡️ Graduation from a nationally accredited associate degree or diploma nursing program
- 🛡️ Holds an unencumbered licensure as a registered nurse in all states where licensed with no pending legal action
- 🛡️ Be in good standing at William Carey University
- 🛡️ Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on all courses taken toward meeting the nursing degree requirement
